What nursing support and personal care workers do



- assist patients with their personal care needs such as showering, dressing and eating
- assist patients with their mobility and communication needs
- participate in planning the care of individuals
- follow therapy plans such as interventions to assist those with dementia and behavioural problems
- observe and report changes in patients' condition, and report complaints about care
- assist with rehabilitation exercises, basic treatment and delivering medications
- provide direct support and assistance to therapists
